Products used in class are included in price. Additional Supplies and tattoo machine of choice are separate, and must be purchased independent of class.

**BASIC AND ONE-ON-ONE GENERAL COURSE
INSTRUCTION INCLUDES:**

- Fifty (50) hours of classroom hands-on application theory
- Twenty (20) hours of pre-class home study

Students must:

- Successfully perform a minimum of 2 eyeliner, 2 eyebrow and 2 lip liner procedures
- Successfully pass the Student Exam by 75% to receive a Certificate of Completion

Upon completion of class, you will receive a Certificate which will allow you to be insured and to participate in memberships

of such organizations as the AAM (American Academy of Micropigmentation or SPCP (Society of Permanent Cosmetic Professionals).

Models are used in class for all hands-on procedures done by students and all work is closely monitored and supervised by the Instructor. All local students will furnish their own models. If the Institute has to provide models when students can't, there is a \$100.00 charge to the student additionally for each area the model has done. Models will be charged a \$100 fee per area for the cost of supplies. We always need models, so if you know anyone who might be interested, please contact the Institute. They will receive quality procedures at a greatly reduced price!
